I wrote to you just a few days ago about meeting you for the first time at the Amellia County fair, and what a wonderful experience it was, but I would like to take a minute of your time to tell you about my Mum.

When my dad's mother was diagnosed with cancer it had spread too rapidly to help her, she was in the hospital for a while but wanted to be home for the remainder of her days.

My Mum stayed with her day in and day out untill her last passing day and tended to her every need including all of her personal hygiene and bedding, she fed her untill she could no longer eat, mu mum was grandmas nurse in every aspect of the word. Her final days even with the pain medications were very difficult untill she finally gave up the fight, as she put it "Im ready to go home". Grandma was a very religious lady. This happened years ago.

Well last year my parents neighbor Jack got sick, he had already been diagnosed with cancer but had been in remission, well Jack was getting up in years but he was very athletic, he worked out on a regular basis and took very good care of himself. Unfortunatley the cancer had returned and gradually he was getting worse, untill he was bedridden. Once again my Mum went into what I call her "Nightingale" mode and went over every evening after work and relieved Jacks girlfriend so that she could have a break (and believe me trying to pull her away from Jack even for a few hours was

tough).

This went on for months until Jack could not move and he was beginning to get bed sores which against his will my mum took care of them. Then one evening Jack lost his battle and my parents lost a very dear friend.

Now this year one of my mum's closest friends that she worked with for years is now diagnosed with bone and lung cancer and again my Mum is right there by her side.

She visits her every week and does what she can to keep her spirits up, she even went to bingo with her, Bonnie insisted, said she didn't have long and mum was her best friend and she wanted to go. Mum said when she saw her last week she was in a lot of pain and looked very weak. We are all praying for a "miracle" for Bonnie, please keep her in your prayers. Also for my mum who seems to always be there for people when they need it and doesn't ever complain about doing it, her name is Roberta, she's a great mum.

I don't know where to begin. I am the father of Joshua Bushu. He was diagnosed with leukemia(ALL) in March of 2000. He was three years old. At that time, a dear friends of ours, Sue Martinic at DeMars in Watervliet, Michigan, contacted you about helping out with the benefit auction they were putting together for our son Josh. I believe she met you at Summer Jam in Benton Harbor, MI where she did the catering. I remember her playing the personal message you left on her machine explaining that you had just gone through a management change and were getting caught up on you communication, you apologized for not getting the message in time to help, but said to let you know if there is ever anything you could do. I will never forget that message. I had a tremendous amount of respect for you before that, but that drove home the fact that you are determined to make a difference in people's lives.

I am happy to tell you that Joshua survived his 38 month ordeal and is now a healthy eight year old. Thanks to generous people such as yourself, Joshua and all of us were able to go to Give Kids the World and Disney World through Make-a-Wish. It was an amazing experience and one we will cherish forever. At that point, my wife Kelly and I made the decision that we would do everything in our power to fight Cancer. We started a Relay for Life team in honor of Joshua three years ago. We have raised \$6,000: \$11,000: \$21,000 in our first three years. We have been able to get Joshua's classmates and friends involved and educated about Cancer.

Kelly and I have also joined the committee for our local relay. We raised \$400,000 last year. This year is our Relay's 10th anniversary and we want to make it special. I am in charge of team development and the Luminaria ceremony. As you are aware, the Luminaria ceremony is a time to remember those who have lost the battle with cancer, celebrate those who have won

their battle, and give hope to those who are fighting for their lives. I know it is a long shot, but I was hoping maybe you could help us this year. I would love nothing more than to have you come and share your story as you did in the ACS video I have. Maybe if you aren't able to do that, you could help in some other way. We are also having a large auction in the spring.

I understand if you aren't able so help us, as you are a busy man and are doing so many great things. No matter what, I want you to know what an inspiration you are to my family. You have truly turned your tragedy into a positive with all the lives you have touched with your story and your music. Thank you for everything you are doing in the fight against Cancer. Hopefully you can drop me a note if you get a chance.
